(1) In Acts 1, the Lord ordained a waiting period before the Holy Spirit wo be poured forth.	uld
(2) In Acts 10 and 11, the Gentiles received the Holy Spirit in the same ma as at Pentecost, speaking in other tongues. This was evidence to those were reluctant to receive Gentiles into the church. This outpouring convinced them that God had saved the Gentiles.	
(3) It is likely that in His sovereignty, Jesus waited to pour forth the Holy Spi until Peter and John arrived so that both the Samaritans and the Jerus church would have no doubt that their experience and equality in Ch were the same.	alem
