Revelation (Adapted from Hayford 1995, 746–747)	
<p><i>God reveals himself, His will, and His ways to humankind. Without this revelation, individuals are unable to know God or His ways.</i></p> <p><b>God Has Revealed Himself to Humanity in Four Ways:</b></p>	
1	Through human conscience in an <b>innate</b> sense of difference between right and wrong (Romans 2:14–15)
2	Through the natural creation by which He has displayed His glory to all humankind (Psalm 19:1–6; Romans 1:20)
3	Through His Word (Micah 6:8; John 20:31; 2 Timothy 3:15)
4	<p>By His Son (John 14:9). Jesus Christ is His fullest and final revelation.  <i>In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways,  but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son,  whom he appointed heir of all things,  and through whom he made the universe.</i>  —Hebrews 1:1–2</p>
	Christ “made Him [God] known” (John 1:18), gave us the words the Father gave Him (John 17:8), and revealed God’s self-giving love at the cross.
