EXAMPLE 1) LOCAL AND BIBLICAL CONTEXT OF THE NOUN...

Reference	Verse	Meaning of flesh (sarx)
Matthew 16:17	"This was not revealed to you by man [flesh and blood], but by my Father in heaven."	Man; people
1 Corinthians 1:26	"Not many of you were wise by [the flesh] human standards."	Human standards
1 Corinthians 15:39	"All flesh is not the same: Men have one kind of flesh, animals have another."	The outer part of the body that covers the bones
Acts 2:26	"Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body [flesh] also will live in hope."	The whole body or person
Galatians 5:17	"For the sinful nature [flesh] desires what is contrary to the Spirit."	The sinful nature or desires in us
