- 2) IN AMERICA AND SOUTH AFRICA, PEOPLE FROM EUROPE SEIZED THE LAND OF THE NATIVE PEOPLE. TO JUSTIFY THIS THEFT THEY QUOTED GOD'S ORDER TO JOSHUA TO KILL THE CANAANITES AND SEIZE THEIR LAND.
